SEEKING INTERESTED CANDIDATES FOR AmeriCorps Community Health Fellowship Program

IN PARTNERSHIP WITH NNCC & CHWCORE

AmeriCorps is a national service initiative focused on building capacity and advancing equitable outcomes in communities.

Community Health Fellows will be placed at Federally Qualified Health Centers (FQHCs) or community health organizations throughout Pennsylvania. Fellows will have the opportunity to complete 300 hours of field placement and 150 hours of online training as part of the Community Health Worker (CHW) Training Program (chwCORE).

During the program, the fellows will receive:

- On-site training & real-time experience focused on Structural Determinants of Health
- \$6,000 stipend (before taxes)
- Educational award is provided upon completion of program
- Networking & professional development

Qualifications:

- Strong interest in community health
- Available during the weekday
- Must be open to serving in underserved areas
- Ability to travel to and from assigned community based organization
