The Institute for Research, Education and Training in Addictions (IRETA) has been tasked with presenting an education curriculum developed by The Department of Drug and Alcohol Programs (DDAP) and The Department of Health (DOH) titled *Evidence-Based Prescribing: Tools You Can Use to Fight the Opioid Epidemic* to health care organizations across the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania. 
